CONTEST RULES

- ELIGIBILITY:** To be eligible to enter the Contest, applicants must either be teaching or enrolled in a Training Partner Member program of the Central Gulf Industrial Alliance (CGIA).
- HOW TO ENTER:** To participate, please register your team by October 1, 2024, by emailing the following information to info@cgialliance.com : School name, Training program, Instructor name, Student names. Limit three (3) entries per CGIA Training Partner program.
An instructor must participate on the team and serve as the point of contact.
- CONTEST REQUIREMENTS:** The sculpture must meet the following criteria:
Get Creative! Have some Fun! Be inspired by Life! The Theme is No Theme! Some past ideas have been Gulf Coast or Industrial based, such as ships and other watercraft, local fish or wildlife, sports, a favorite football team; etc. but feel free to expand your thoughts and use your imagination!
The sculpture must be made out of industrial materials used in your craft – metals, plastics, fiberglass, wood, wire and electrical components (no capacitors, please). You can use original parts or modify them to fit your idea.
The completed sculpture may not exceed 18" (L) x 18" (W) x 18" (H) in size nor 45 pounds, unless preapproved by CGIA.
CGIA reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any entrant who submits an inappropriate or offensive sculpture.
Once your sculpture is complete - please contact Jonie Pace at info@cgialliance.com to schedule a location and date to deliver your sculpture. CGIA needs to have possession of the sculpture by Wednesday, October 23, 2024.
- SILENT AUCTION:** The sculpture receiving the highest paid bid at the General Membership Meeting will be declared the winner! We will accept Cash, PayPal, Check or Credit Card.
- NOTIFICATION OF WINNERS:** Contest winners will be notified at the end of the meeting on November 7, 2024.
- PRIZES:** The winning team will receive \$250 and the school will receive the remaining donations collected (\$250 minimum) to cover materials and reinvest into the program.
In the event of a tie, total prize money will be split between the winning teams.
